For November 17th, 2013

Facility use requests:

Jan Jenkins and Suellen Skinner request use of the Fellowship Hall and kitchen for a Prayer Shawl meeting on January 18, 2014 from 9AM to 3PM. Approximately 60 persons are expected to attend.

Requests approved.

Motion to recognize Eileen Bagent who in November passed on to be with the Lord. Approved.

Moderators Report: Rev. Allison reported that his house has been placed on the market in Mansfield. He and Becky are looking at homes in the Zanesville area.

Deacon Report: Minutes received.

Presbytery: Scheduled to recognize Dr. Schumacher on the event of his pastor Emeritus status at the next meeting.

A question was raised regarding participation in a pulpit exchange. Session elected to opt out as we are just coming out of a period guest ministers filling the pulpit, and just beginning a routine with Rev. Allison.

Worship and Music Report: On Sunday November 3, 2013, communion was served to 110. Christmas Caroling will be Sunday, December 8, 2013 following the potluck dinner. The Northside Community Churches Thanksgiving eve service will not be held at Trinity United Presbyterian Church.

Motion from committee: that Trinity United Presbyterian Church have a Thanksgiving Eve service on Wednesday evening, November 27, 2013, in the chapel. Discussed and approved.

Outreach: Reported with no action items. The committee plans to meet this week.

Christian Education: Reported with no action items. Held two Acolyte training sessions. The Christmas program is being planned. We are planning to do the 'Cookies for Service Workers' for Xmas eve. Over 20 cards were donated to Operation Spirit. There will be a Christmas potluck after church on Dec 8, 2013. Snacks after service has been well received. We are ready for the Hanging of the Greens, CE may provide pizza. Amanda will be giving out small gifts to kids for Advent. On December 29, 2013, Amanda wants to show Superman for Sunday School.

Received a call from Tom Price regarding the renewal of our insurance policy. The premium would increase to over \$500. If we change to \$500 deductible from \$250, the cost of premium would be roughly the same.

A motion was made to switch to the \$500 deductible. The motion was discussed and approved.

The stewardship campaign will start in early 2014. A letter to the congregation will be sent out in 2-3 weeks.

Report was accepted.

Personnel: No Report.

Nominating & Membership: Met regarding nominations for elder and deacons, the committee is almost done with its work.

A motion was made to grant authority to committee to call a congregational meeting when they complete the slate of nominees. Approved.

Building and Grounds: Reported with no action items.

Missions: Motion from committee: That a collection be taken to support the group 'Active Christians Today', a campus ministry at the University of Toledo where Kaylan Patteson is a student and member of ACT; that the collection will be used to support a needy family at Christmas time. The collection will be made through December 1, 2013. Approved.

Youth Committee: 10 of 12 members participated in the Annual Souper Bowl and experience the fun, friendship and rewards of serving others. Currently the group is working on a bake sale, so far earning approximately \$150 to buy gifts for 3 'Angels' from the Salvation Army

Tree at the mall. The youth will do the gift shopping on December 1, 2013 following the worship service.

New Business:

A motion was made to create a plaque honoring Paul Thorburn. The plaque will accompany his photo is in the library. Elder Jenkins offered that Bob Jenkins will do the woodworking to create the plaque. Approved.



The meeting was called to order and opened with prayer by Rev. Allison at 11:50AM. A quorum was declared.

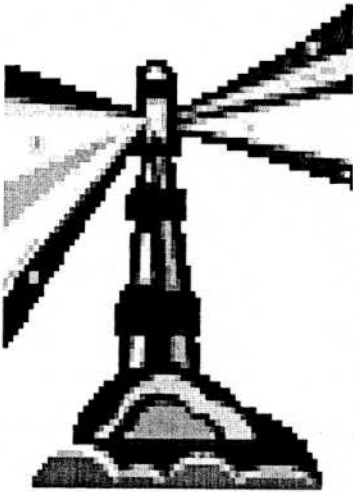
A motion was made to accept the slate of nominees and seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.
